Regina Coeli Catholic School Revised COVID-19 Policies Effective 2/7/2022

Based on changes in the policies of the Ohio Department of Health and the Toledo Lucas County Health Department, the following revisions to the COVID-19 policies of Regina Coeli Catholic School will go into effect immediately:

Regardless of vaccination status, students who are exposed to a COVID positive person **and are asymptomatic** are no longer required to quarantine at home. Students may come to school provided they wear a mask at all times except when eating or drinking. Any student who shows any symptoms must isolate/quarantine until symptoms resolve and/or for a minimum of 5 days if a COVID positive test result is obtained.

Any student who tests positive for COVID-19 must isolate at home for a minimum of 5 days. Any student who shows two or more symptoms must isolate for 5 days. The student may return to school at the end of the 5 days. If symptoms continue, student must continue to isolate at home until all symptoms have resolved without the use of medication.

If you prefer that your child quarantine at home, please contact school to discuss length of quarantine and dates to return.
