COVID Quarantine and Isolation Updates

Per instructions from the Health Department on January 11, 2022 the following is in effect: Vaccinated students who are exposed to a COVID positive person, either do not need to quarantine. They must wear a mask at school.

Unvaccinated students who have a parent or sibling in the home who tests positive for COVID must quarantine for 14 days from the time the parent tests positive. If a child is exposed to a COVID positive case outside of the home, they must quarantine for a minimum of 10 days.

If a child tests positive they must quarantine for 10 days.
